

Developmental Milestones

6 Months


- Moves objects to mouth & between hands
- Makes babbling sounds
- Responds to own name
- Begins to sit without support
- Rolls over in both directions

12 Months



- Tries to copy words
- Sits without support
- Pokes or points with index finger
- Pulls up to stand

18 Months



- Says several single words
- Drinks from a cup
- Points to show you something
- Knows what ordinary things are

2 Years



- Begins to run & climb
- Begins to sort & build with blocks
- Walks up & down stairs while holding on
- Says sentences with 2-4 words

3 Years



- Climbs & runs well
- Takes turns in games
- Carries conversation using 2-3 sentences
- Knows name & age
- Turns pages of book

4 Years



- Tells stories
- Hops & stands on one foot
- Enjoys playing with other children
- Can say first & last name
- Names some colors & numbers
