Iowa Child Care Guidance in Response to Covid-19

- Face Coverings are encouraged for adults and school age children.
- Physical Distancing
 - Room capacity should be based on the ability physically distance
 - Ensure children and staff groupings are as static as possible.

- Hygiene and Cleaning
 - Frequent handwashing and cleaning
 - Minimize the sharing of high touch materials or items that are difficult to clean or disinfect
- Screen and Testing
 - Daily Health Checks
 - Reporting process if illness occurs for children or staff



Iowa Current Vacancies

Iowa created a map showing open programs and vacancies. This is being updated twice per week.

Other data:

- Scott County had 297 total programs listed with Child Care Resource and Referral in July 2020. (312 in July 2019)
- This includes 200+ that remained closed in August 2020.
 Some of the temp programs were planning to open with the school district. Others are unsure if they will be able reopen.
